#### **Improving College Readiness**

College is now the threshold of employability. Within this decade, 72% of jobs in Massachusetts will require some college education. A college degree is no longer optional; it is an economic necessity. But too many of our high school graduates are not prepared for college-level work and do not graduate. JFYNet's College Readiness program prepares students for college work by using the Accuplacer diagnostic and placement tests to assess academic needs and prescribe individualized instructional programs to meet those needs. JFYNet Accuplacer Prep has helped students reduce the need for remedial college courses by 50%.



#### **Closing Achievement Gaps**

American students are not achieving up to their potential or up to the demands of global competition. Our high school students, especially low income and minority students, place low on international tests of math and reading and fall short of college entrance requirements. As a result, American employers cannot find the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy. 


### Blended Learning: AIM<sup>2</sup>

Blended Learning is the fusion of online and teacher-led instruction. It selects and organizes the vast resources of the internet into customized instructional units and places them in the skilled hands of the classroom teacher. Blended learning is the tool that enables teachers to practice student-centered instruction. Our approach to blended learning is described by the acronym AIM<sup>2</sup>: Assess, Instruct. Measure and Manage.
